zView provides a way to share the zSpace experience with others. zView enables you to project a user's experience with zSpace onto a second monitor or screen.

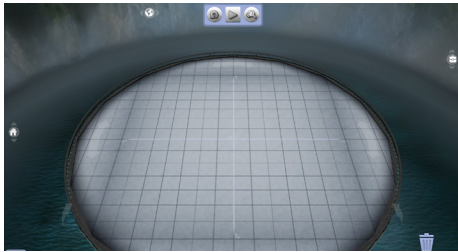
zView is controlled differently in different applications:

zSpace Experience

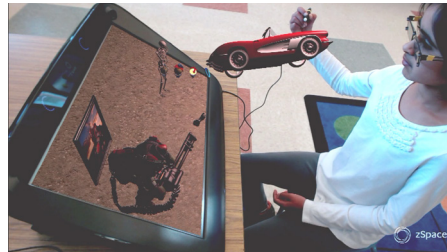
Z Turns zView on

X Switches zView perspective from Presenter View to Augmented Reality View and back

C Pauses zView

zView is controlled through a new menu that appears at the top (zView in-app control bar)
